

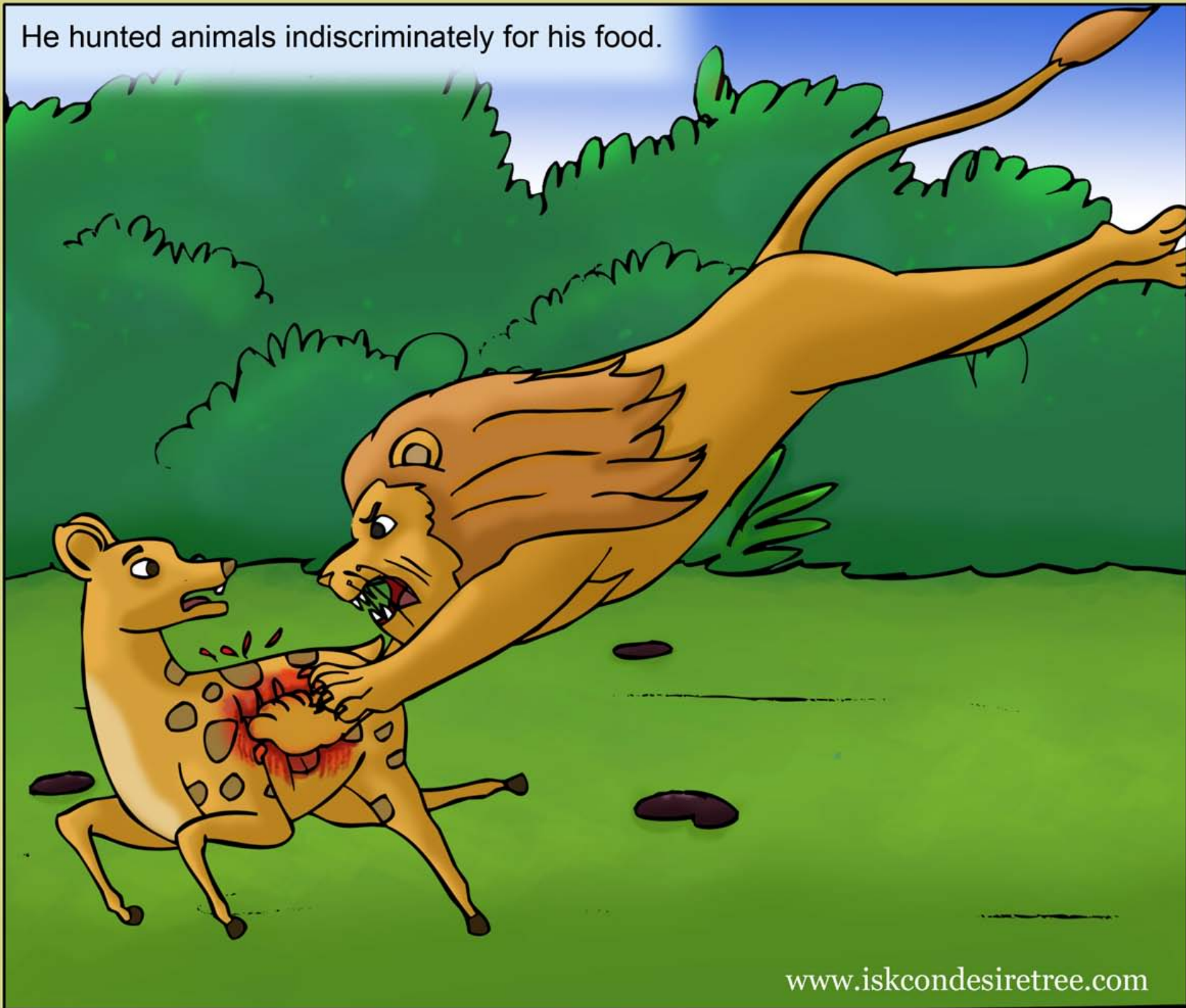
Rabbit and the lion

in that case.

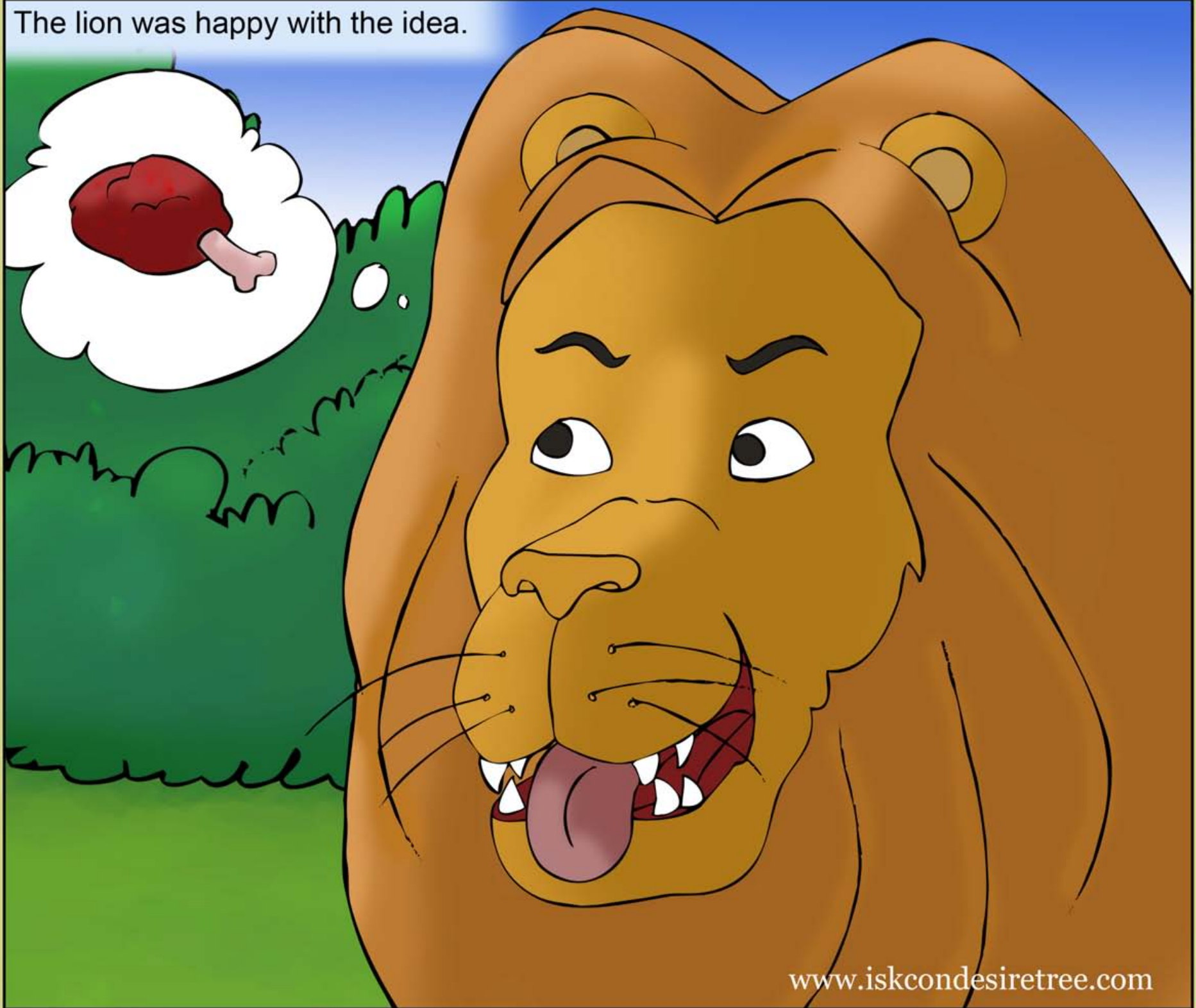


What is your
suggestion ?

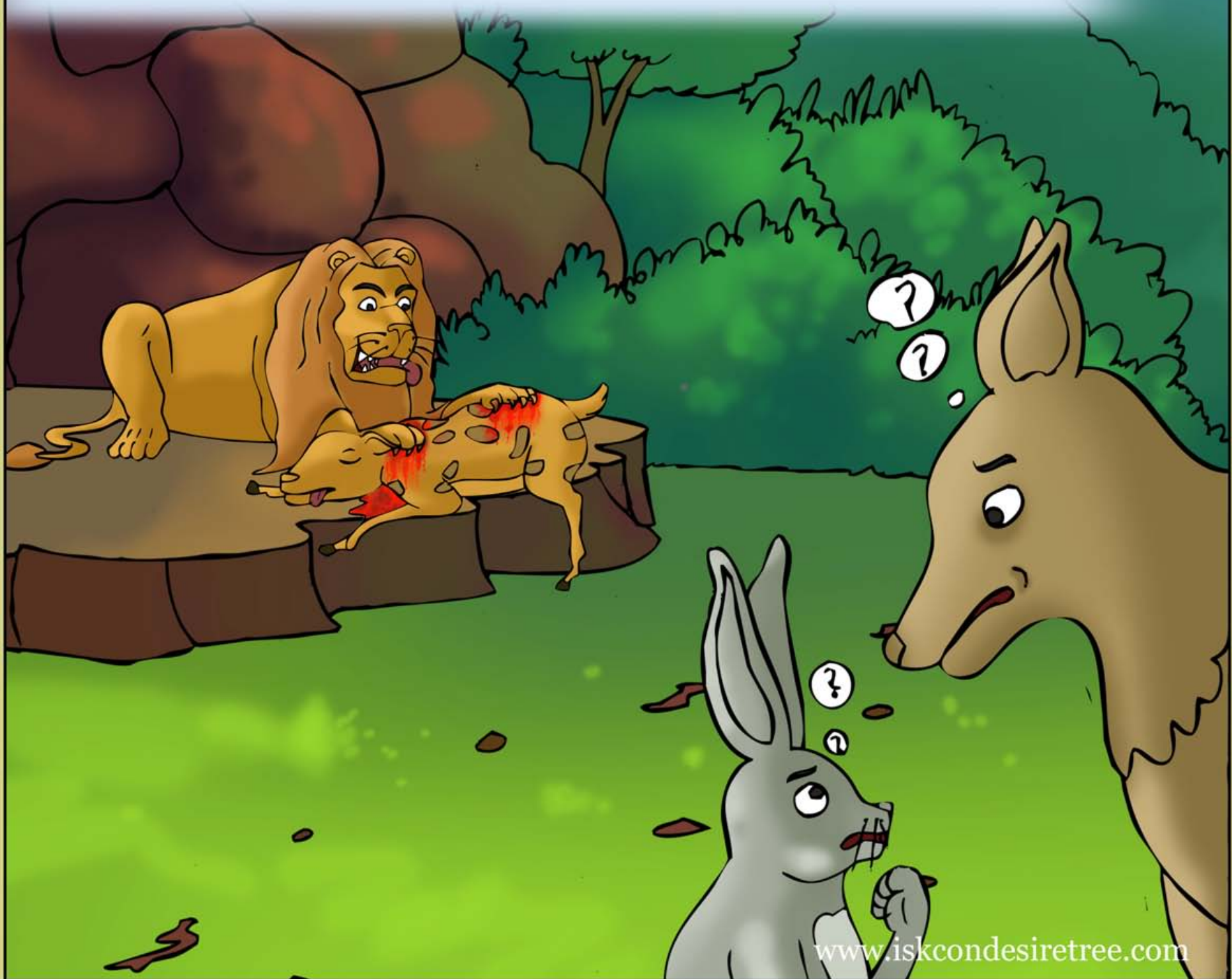


King we will

us for future.

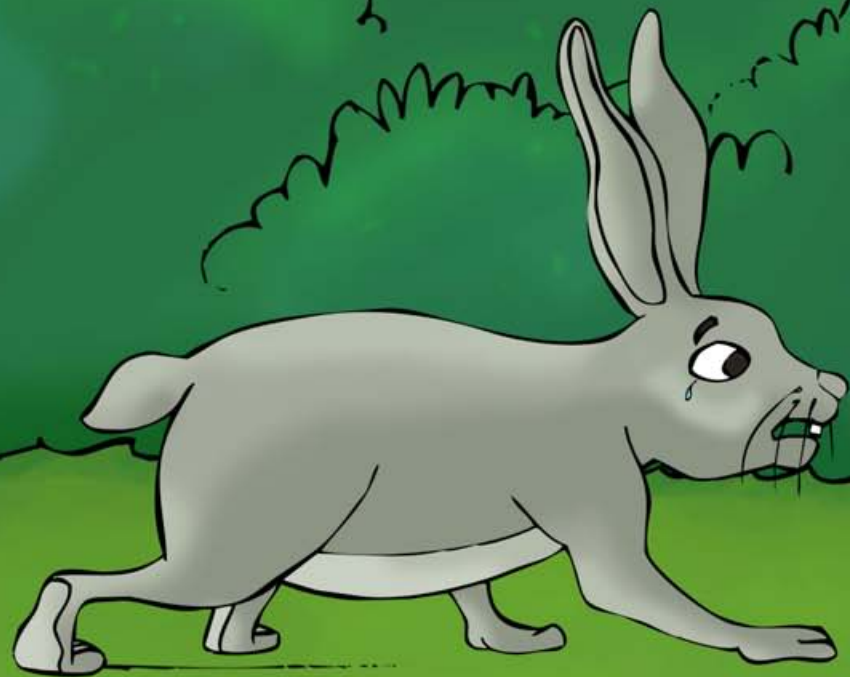
The lion was happy with the idea.
