Advaita Acharya is the combined incarnation of Maha Visnu and Sadaishiva (who resides in Goloka). His two consorts, Sita and Sri are manifestations of Yoga Maya. His son Acyutananda was born of Sita Devi. Advaita Acharya had two residences, one in Santipur, the other not far from Srivasa's home in Mayapur.
